Bursaries are available now for Wales based **artists** and **arts organisations** to see new work, network and attend key professional sessions at the Greenwich +Docklands International Festival (GDIF) and Xtrax Showcase 26 -28 June.

Through these bursaries the aim is to create a wider arena of sharing, connections and collaborations for the development of outdoor arts in Wales, as well as to initiate a distinct Welsh presence at this leading international event.

The bursaries are supported by the Arts Council of Wales, Creu Cymru and Articulture.

GDIF has been growing every year and in 2013, the Festival featured over 150 performances by 30 national and international companies with more than 80,000 people attending the outdoor shows in East and South London.

The Festival is committed to breaking new ground in outdoor performance and raising the ambition, quality and diversity of outdoor work produced in the UK, with a particular focus on the commissioning and development of outdoor work led by Deaf and disabled artists and artists from diverse backgrounds.

8 artist bursaries are available. Each bursary is up to £300 and covers festival/showcase registration, as well as a contribution towards travel, and accommodation for 3 nights. Articulture asks for a £50 deposit in advance to secure your bursary, refunded on the day of the Festival.
