Outdoor Arts Bursaries - Greenwich & Docklands International Festival 2018

About the Bursaries

Bursaries are available for Wales based artists and arts organisations interested in or working in outdoor arts, to see new work, network, and attend professional sessions at leading outdoor arts event the Greenwich & Docklands International Festival.

This also includes the opportunity to take part in the GDIF Festival Hub, hosted by the Independent Street Arts Network, with a packed programme of professional networking and development activities.

The bursaries cover the period from Fri 22 – Sun 24 June, when the Festival launches, and the Hub is active, with Articulture informally hosting successful bursary applicants for the weekend in the heart of Greenwich, London (note the Hub is active from Thurs 21 if you wish go earlier, but the Articulture hosted visit will not commence until the Fri)

The aim of the bursaries is to help create a wider arena of sharing, connections and collaborations for the development of outdoor arts in Wales, as well as to ensure a distinct Welsh presence at this leading international event.

The bursaries are funded by the Arts Council of Wales.

About the Greenwich & Docklands International Festival

Greenwich+Docklands International Festival (GDIF) is London's leading festival of free outdoor performing arts (theatre, dance, circus and street arts). Alongside the high profile programme of international and UK acts is a series of outdoor arts industry events.

GDIF Festival Hub hosted by the Independent Street Arts Network offers a packed programme of opportunities, inviting artists, festival directors, programmers, funders and all those with a professional interest in Outdoor Arts to develop skills, reflect on the work of the sector, and take advantage of excellent networking opportunities in an informal and friendly atmosphere.

Apply for a Bursary

6 bursaries are available in total. These are to cover your travel. Simple accommodation is provided together with others near the festival for 3 nights (Thurs 21 – Sat 23 June). Festival/Hub registration is free.

Articulture will informally hosting the group of successful bursary applicants, providing guidance throughout the weekend.

Please note that Articulture cannot support anyone who has already received a bursary for attending a festival from us previously and applicants must be able to attend the full three days.
