What is this?

Tyfu a Rhannu helps artists in Wales.

It supports **outdoor arts**.

It helps artists to:

- develop work that is already in progress further
- get support and mentoring
- share work with festivals and programmers

👉 This programme is for **work already being made**.

👉 We are **not funding brand new ideas**.

What kind of work can I apply with?

The work must be:

- for **outdoor performance**
- **already in progress**

For example:

- street theatre
- circus
- dance
- puppetry
- walkabout
- participatory work

Who is Articulture?

Articulture supports outdoor arts in Wales.

We:

- work with artists at different stages
- help artists develop their work
- connect artists with audiences and festivals

What do you get if selected?

If you are chosen, you will get:

- Up to **12 hours of paid mentoring**
- Support from a **producer**
- Help with:
 - marketing
 - technical information
 - access information
- **Payment** to take part in the showcase
- **A filmed video** of your work
- **A 1-minute promo video**
- Chances to meet festival organisers and programmers

When does it happen?

- Spring and summer **2026**
- Showcase in **late September 2026**
- Showcase will be **accessible**
- Showcase will be held in **Wales**

ARTICULTURE

Who can apply?

You can apply if you:

- live in **Wales**
- are making outdoor work
- are at **any career stage**

You can apply:

- on your own
- or as a small group (up to 4 people)

We welcome artists who are:

- under-represented in outdoor arts

You can apply in:

- Welsh
- English
- BSL

What we do NOT fund

We do not fund:

- new commissions
- finished touring work
- equipment costs

How do I apply?

There is **one set of questions**.

You choose **how to answer**.

You can ask to talk to someone from Articulture.

You can ask for support, for example:

- BSL interpreter
- Welsh language conversation
- other access support
